

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

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

11. World AIDS Day

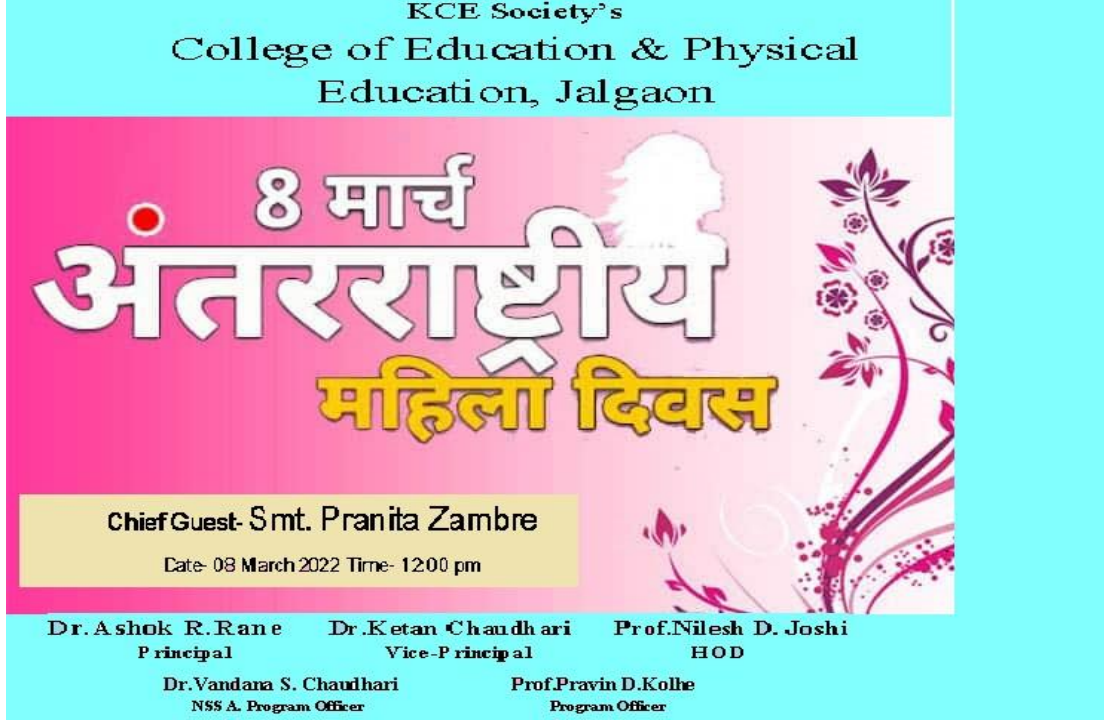


Following curriculum and co-curriculum programme were conducted during the internship in above school as per planning and guidance of mentor Intern students join all activities & Programs :-
