Teaching, knowledge of learning, engaging and motivating students, lesson planning and implementation, collaboration with school and school teachers, improving knowledge of new teaching techniques, relationship with the building school environment, examining and adjusting instruction, leadership opportunities, and effective classroom management. These skills are critical for effective teaching and decision making for teachers. Mentors viewed possibly getting involved with administration, serving as a consultant, or owning their own school.
