Recognition Order

SPRINT-POST

Whereas in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. COLLEGE CAMPUS, F.P. NO. 2, T.P.S. III OF MEHRUN SHIVAR, DIST. JALGAON, MAHARASHTRA, a minority institution, has submitted an application (Code No.- APW07802/124077/124041 (Appeal) to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting M.P.ED. (M) (CO-ED) course with an annual intake of 30 students on 24.10.2008.

And whereas, in its 133rd meeting held on April 20-21, 2010 the Western Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution decided to refuse recognition u/s 15 of NCTE Act of the institution for M.P.ED. (M) (CO-ED) course and accordingly the refusal order No. WRC/APW07802/124077/133/2010/67621-67626 dated 04.05.2010 was issued to the institution.

And whereas, the correspondent, EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. COLLEGE CAMPUS, F.P. NO. 2, T.P.S. III OF MEHRUN SHIVAR, DIST. JALGAON, MAHARASHTRA, has preferred an appeal to NCTE New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order of WRC.

And whereas, having considered the oral submission by the representative of the institution, the written representation, the record of the case and V.T. Report, the Appellate Authority decided to reverse the order of NCTE, WRC with direction to WRC to grant recognition to the institution immediately.

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. COLLEGE CAMPUS, F.P. NO. 2, T.P.S. III OF MEHRUN SHIVAR, DIST. JALGAON, MAHARASHTRA for conducting M.P.ED. (M) (CO-ED) course of PG-PE of 1 years duration with an annual intake of 30 (Thirty) seats (PG-PE) from academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation 2009.

The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

The recognition will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session be fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

Post recognition conditions are as under:-

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund account into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Western Regional Committee.

- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other Norms and Standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iv) Further, the institution should fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc., wherever applicable.
- (v) The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the formal is enclosed with the order.
- (vi) If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
- (vii) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars.
 - Staff Profile.
 - Recognition letter.
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
